SUMMER SPLASH: CUTTING THE RIBBON ON A REVITALIZED BELOVED LOCAL POOL

On July 11, MP Zoe Royer celebrated the newly revitalized Mundy Outdoor Pool complex, a popular Coquitlam community recreation amenity for more than 50 years.

Cutting the ribbon with First Nations, municipal, provincial and federal government partners, the project included \$2.4 million in federal funds from the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program.

Families, friends and nearby residents welcomed the new leisure pool with accessible beach entry, a modernized washroom/change room facility, shade structures and seating areas, and other upgrades.

APPLY NOW **CANADA DISABILITY BENEFIT**

For the first time in Canadian history, our government is delivering a federal benefit specifically designed for working-age persons with disabilities. The Canada Disability Benefit (CDB) is a monthly benefit providing eligible individuals ages 18-64 up to \$2,400 annually – and the first payments are already rolling out! We encourage all potential applicants to reach out if they have any questions or inquiries about the CDB. Our office is happy to assist you!

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE CANADA DISABILITY BENEFIT, YOU MUST:

- ✓ Be a resident of Canada for the purposes of the *Income Tax Act*;
- ✓ Have been approved for the Disability Tax Credit;
- ✓ Be between the ages of 18 and 64;
- ✓ Have filed an income tax return with the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) for the previous tax year; and,
- ✓ Be one of the following:

- A Canadian citizen;
- A permanent resident;
- A protected person;
- A temporary resident who has lived in Canada for the past 18 months; or,
- Someone who is registered or entitled to be registered under the *Indian Act*.

NOTE: If you're married or have a common-law partner, your partner must also have filed an income tax and benefit return with the CRA for the previous tax year. In some exceptional cases, this requirement may be waived.

YOU CAN CHOOSE TO APPLY IN A BARRIER-FREE, ACCESSIBLE WAY THAT WORKS BEST FOR YOU, INCLUDING SELF-SERVE OPTIONS, ONLINE, BY PHONE, OR WITH OFFICER SUPPORT, IF NEEDED.

IF APPLYING IN PERSON, YOU CAN RECEIVE ASSISTANCE WITH THE APPLICATION PROCESS AT YOUR NEAREST SERVICE CANADA LOCATION.
